

The Cup competition this year has been changed to consist of two (2) Singles matches and 3 doubles matches. For the mixed competition, the matches will be 1 x Men's Doubles, 1 x Ladies Doubles, 1 x Mixed Doubles and 2 x Singles, (1 Men's and 1 Ladies). Players will play either singles or mixed and each player will play 2 matches.

For the Men's and Ladies teams, a similar format will be used. Teams will consist of four players; pairs must play in order of their combined grading points; singles players must play in order of their grading points. The two players chosen as the singles players may not play together in the doubles and each player must play two matches.

Teams are allowed to change the partnerships for the next round of the competition. Teams must exchange team sheets before the start of the match. A combined team sheet will then be completed to record the scores and it will be the responsibility of the home team to return the result to the Competitions Secretary. Each match shall consist of the best of 3 games and shall be played in accordance with existing County rules.

Men's or Ladies example: Team consisting of Player A, Player B, Player C and Player D.

1st Singles Player C

2nd Singles Player D

Players C & D cannot play together in the doubles, therefore,

1st Pair Player A and Player B

2nd Pair Player B and Player C

3rd Pair Player A and Player D
